## Letter to Year 12 Students and Parents

Dear Year 12 Students and Parents,

Further to my email sent on Thursday 8 July 2021, please note the following:

1. Year 12 students **will need to attend school from Tuesday 13 July to Friday 16 July in order to sit their HSC Trial examinations 1.**
2. Students who are absent will be treated in accordance with the school illness/misadventure procedure.
3. Year 12 Students are to report to the School Grand hall upon 15 minutes prior to their exam. **Entry and exit to the examinations will be via Nagle Street only.**
4. Staff and Year 12 students attending school during week 1 of term 3, will be under strict covid-19 guidelines restrictions, i.e. wearing a mask and exercising social distancing.
5. All students to be wearing masks at all times. Please arrange to bring your own mask, if not available, the school will provide its students with a face mask.
6. Students are expected to leave school immediately after examinations via Nagle St gate. Parents are to observe the examinations timetable and make sure they arrange pick up immediately at the end of each examination day.
7. The school canteen will remain closed and all students are required to bring food, drink, water. The school water fountains will be closed and not available for drinking from.
8. Students travelling by public transport are to be wearing masks and follow the rules as per required. Students may use their School ID cards as an evidence that they are school students.
9. Parents who are dropping off or picking up students are required to do so outside the school gate and remain in their cars as per usual procedure.
10. Strict social distancing practices will be put into place at all times in school. Given our school is small in numbers, there will be small groups at all times in classrooms where required.
