ATTENDANCE

It is important that your child arrives at school on time (8:20 a.m.). Children like to have a few minutes before the day starts to do things such as catch up with friends.

If your child arrives late (after 8:40 a.m.), you will need to get a late slip from the front office; this is the same process if you are taking your child out

of school early for any reason. The time is noted in the teachers' Attendance Register and is considered a Partial Absence. This Partial Absence

is then noted on your child's report. Students will need to get a late note from the office if they

arrive to school after 8:40 a.m.

As the school is responsible for the welfare and safety of students, it is necessary for us to know their whereabouts at all times. If parents wish to

collect children during school hours, they must go to the office first to sign their children out of the school. Written permission is required from the

parents or guardians for any other person to collect your child and identification must be sighted.

LOST PROPERTY

Make sure that all school items and clothing are clearly labelled with name, class and school.



Students are not to bring valuable items to school, as the school will not be held responsible for any lost items. If something has been lost, ask about the item at the front office.

CANTEEN

The school canteen is open each day for recess and lunch. Students may place a lunch order by bringing the correct change for food that they wish to purchase. Please place lunch order money in a sealed envelope and indicate whether it is a recess or lunch order. A menu and price list was provided to all students at the start of the school year.

Parents will need to complete the canteen permission note in order for their child to purchase from the canteen. Parents can help their child to concentrate and achieve to the best of their ability at school by packing a healthy, substantial lunch every day.




