Science Incursion

Students of 3A and 3/4M had the opportunity to partake in an incursion looking at liquid, solids and gases. Students assisted in the many cool liquid nitrogen demonstrations. Students found out how solids, liquids and gases change when rapidly heated and cooled. They smashed a tennis ball! Saw how to shrink a balloon instantly! Found out if living things are frozen as well as popping cans and expanding balls. Students had a great time, they were very well behaved. Well done year 3 and 4.



Sushi Report

Year 4 have been learning about “Our Asian Neighbours” during our Geography sessions. To enhance this experience, an incursion was organised with the Kids Love to Cook team.

First our host Beth, taught us about food safety and hygiene when preparing food.

Next, she demonstrated how to cut our vegetables, place tuna or salmon inside the sushi and spread the rice over the nori.

We learnt how to roll the sushi using a bamboo board. We really had to concentrate when rolling the sushi so that the roll would stay together.

As a bonus activity, we also made sushi balls. We placed rice and fillings into a ball and moulded them into a tear drop shape. We topped this off with black sesame seeds.

Overall, a wonderful time was had by all. The students gained a unique experience into the world of Asian cuisine.


This great program aligns with Al Amanah College's mission to equip our youth of today with the power to make safe decisions and promote a great sense of well-being.
